University of Alaska System Created in 1987

Why?


- Financial Crisis in the State
- Desire for better coordination
- Capture economies of scale many small institutions

How?

- Regional Education Delivery south central, interior & northwest, southeast
- Consolidate Research State Public Service mission at UAF
- 11 Separately Accredited Institutions consolidated into 3 (UAA, UAF, UAS)

University of Alaska System – 24 years later What Has Worked?

- During 13 years of financial strain Campuses survived
- During 11 years of relative "good-times"
 - Number of Programs Offerings Increased,
 - Offerings 'coordinated'
 - access to programs expanded
- More relevant in the state, more students chose UA
- Consolidated Administrative and Business Functions



Political and Regulatory Environment

- State of Alaska is the primary funding for UA educational mission (unrestricted operating)
 - students pay some
- University of Alaska Board of Regents has significant governance power from the Alaska Constitution
- Federal Government is the primary source for research funding (restricted, competitive, and project based)



Challenges Remain

- Homogeneous Policies vs Diverse Operations/Mission
 - Community & Technical College Cost and Mission
 - Faculty Salary/Union Research/Instruction
- Campus Identity Aspirational Model
- Bottom-up desires vs Top-down strategic direction


