





International PhD School "Russia in the Arctic dialogue"

Northern Arctic Federal University (Arkhangelsk, North-West Russia) is pleased to announce the International PhD School "Russia in the Arctic Dialogue", to be held as a side event of the V International Arctic Forum "Arctic: Territory of Dialogue" that will take place at the university venue at the end of March 2019.

Since 2011 the International Forum "Arctic: the Territory of Dialogue" has served as the key arena in Russia for addressing the issues of the Arctic exploration and sustainable development in the national and global context. The Forum is organized biannually under the auspices of the RF Government and attracts presidents, high officials, diplomats, experts and scholars from all over the world. Northern Arctic Federal University will host the event for the third time.

Over the last decades the Arctic is on the top of the agenda for world political leaders, business, public and academia due to new emerging opportunities effecting economic, political and social dynamics in local communities and globally. All stakeholders emphasize that the dialogue and international collaboration in the region is crucial for ensuring its sustainable development.

The aim of the International PhD School "Russia in the Arctic Dialogue" is to provide young researchers from Arctic and non-Arctic countries with the knowledge about the Russian Arctic Strategy and large-scale projects and facilitate international collaboration in studying and discussing contemporary issues of the Arctic region in global context. Russian and foreign high officials and speakers of the International Forum are invited for keynote lecturers and discussions.

The **School** participants will be able to discuss a vast scope of current issues of the Arctic, incl. Arctic law, Northern governance and economies, life of the local communities, human adaptation in the Arctic environment, Arctic as an art object, international cooperation in the Arctic.

Structure of the programme

Includes lectures, presentations, interactive sessions, debates, side events, cultural and site visits.
